wording

You can word your invitations in any way you wish. The wording of your invitation should give guests an indication of your wedding's style, whether it's a very formal event, or a more relaxed intimate affair.

To make life simple we've come up with standard traditional and contemporary versions of invitation wording. These can be used as they are or as a starting point for your own ideas...

There are any number of variations you may wish to use, including those listed below.

instead of "*request the pleasure of your company*"

- request the honour of your presence
- invite you to join them for
- very much hope you will join them in celebrating

instead of "*and for the reception after*"

- followed by dinner and dancing / cocktails and canapés / afternoon tea on the lawn
- and after for the wedding breakfast

Dates and times can be written as words or figures, exactly as you wish.

You may also wish to add further details at the end, such as:

- dress code: black tie
- carriages at midnight
- your response would be appreciated by...(date)

fonts

The font you choose can change the look of your stationery. We've put together a range of options from elegant to funky, just choose the one that suits your style. As with everything else, should you have any particular ideas about the layout and fonts for your invitations, then let us know and we'll do our best to incorporate them.

The text in your invitations will be printed in black or grey as appropriate. For a small extra charge you can also choose to all or some of the text printed in a colour to suit. If you'd like to see examples, just let us know.

extras

As well as the invitation itself, you may wish to send a pre-addressed R.S.V.P. card. This makes it simple to collate replies, and can include information about dietary requirements etc.

You probably have a wealth of information to share with your guests: directions to venues, suggestions for accommodation, details of gift lists, etc. We can produce a co-ordinating information card (or sheet, as required) to include with your invitations. Prices for this service vary depending on exactly what's required, starting from 50 p for a simple information card.
